"But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;" — 1 PETER 3:15 (NKJV) —

In 1 Peter 3:9, Peter tells the believers, to not repay evil with evil. The believers were facing persecution so Peter needed to remind them to love even their enemies. He tells them, when people insult them, they should bless them instead of trying to get revenge.

## Pastor Solomon Reyes Testimony:

As CABC has been blessed this year to have a new Associate Pastor, we welcome him (and his family) to the CABC family. May you be inspired and blessed by his testimony.

The LORD has appeared of old to me, saying: "Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you.

— JEREMIAH 31:3 —

I grew up in a home that was religious but devoid of gospel truth that is the power of God unto salvation. However, through my readings of a picture bible I began to develop an idea of what sin was and God's judgment and condemnation of it. I remember as a young person, I had a dream that I ended up in hell and woke up very troubled and afraid.

Nobody taught me how to sin. I did that all by myself. It was in my nature to sin. And yet, I looked at myself as a good person. I thought my good works would outweigh my sin and I would still end up in heaven if I died. God graciously preserved me despite my blinded and self-deceived assurance. But there was a growing emptiness inside of me that I could not understand.

I felt like my life was a barren desert with a few patches of green. There was a gnawing darkness of despair that threatened to swallow up my soul. But even then, God was keeping me with His everlasting love. God sovereignly brought people into my life to connect me to Himself and His people. There was Vic who patiently endured my arrogant resistance to the gospel. We had Bible studies which the Lord would use to open my eyes to the truth. The Scripture that spoke to me was:

For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,[9] not of works, lest anyone should boast.

— *EPHESIANS 28:9* —

Eventually I would realize that my righteousness was but as filthy rags before the perfect, Holy God. I began to understand that by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified before Him; and that the only way to be forgiven and saved is to be justified freely by the grace of Christ. On March 9, 1986, as a visiting

pastor preached on Ephesians 2, I embraced the Lord Jesus by faith as my Lord and Savior. From that day, I began to experience the reality of what Paul wrote in his epistle to the Corinthians:

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

- 2 CORINTHIANS 5:7 -

The emptiness that I had felt before was gone. I had much to learn as a new believer in Christ, but I found the meaning and purpose in life that I had long been searching for through Christ.

My family migrated here in Canada in 1990. I worked in Canada Trust for about nine years. Then the Lord called me to full time ministry in 1999 in Peel International Baptist Church (a daughter church of CABC) where I previously served as a deacon. We went to the Philippines for my studies at the Doane Baptist Seminary, where I got my Bachelor Degree in Religious Education. We came back in 2002 and served in Peel International Baptist Church. In 2008, the Lord called us to serve in the United States at Union Community Bible Church until September 2018, when the Lord called us to serve here in CABC. I thank God for the mentorship of more experienced pastors like Pastor Elbern Latorilla and Pastor Eliezer Catanus. I am grateful to God for my loving and supportive wife, Ethel. And for our precious children, David, John and Jada. The journey has not always been easy. God never promised us a rose garden, but He did promise us that He will never leave us nor forsake us... and that is enough.
